INTERMEDIATE SERVICE

Periodic GPS Tracking:

With this service we would monitor the client's GPS unit only when we get instructions to do so. This is useful for those that do not spend a lot of time on the streets and are mostly in their office, but that sometimes need to go to a meeting or event where they would feel more secure if they were being monitored.

Instructions can be transmitted either by phone, Nextel or pre-arranged email or text messages.

Threat Intelligence Support:

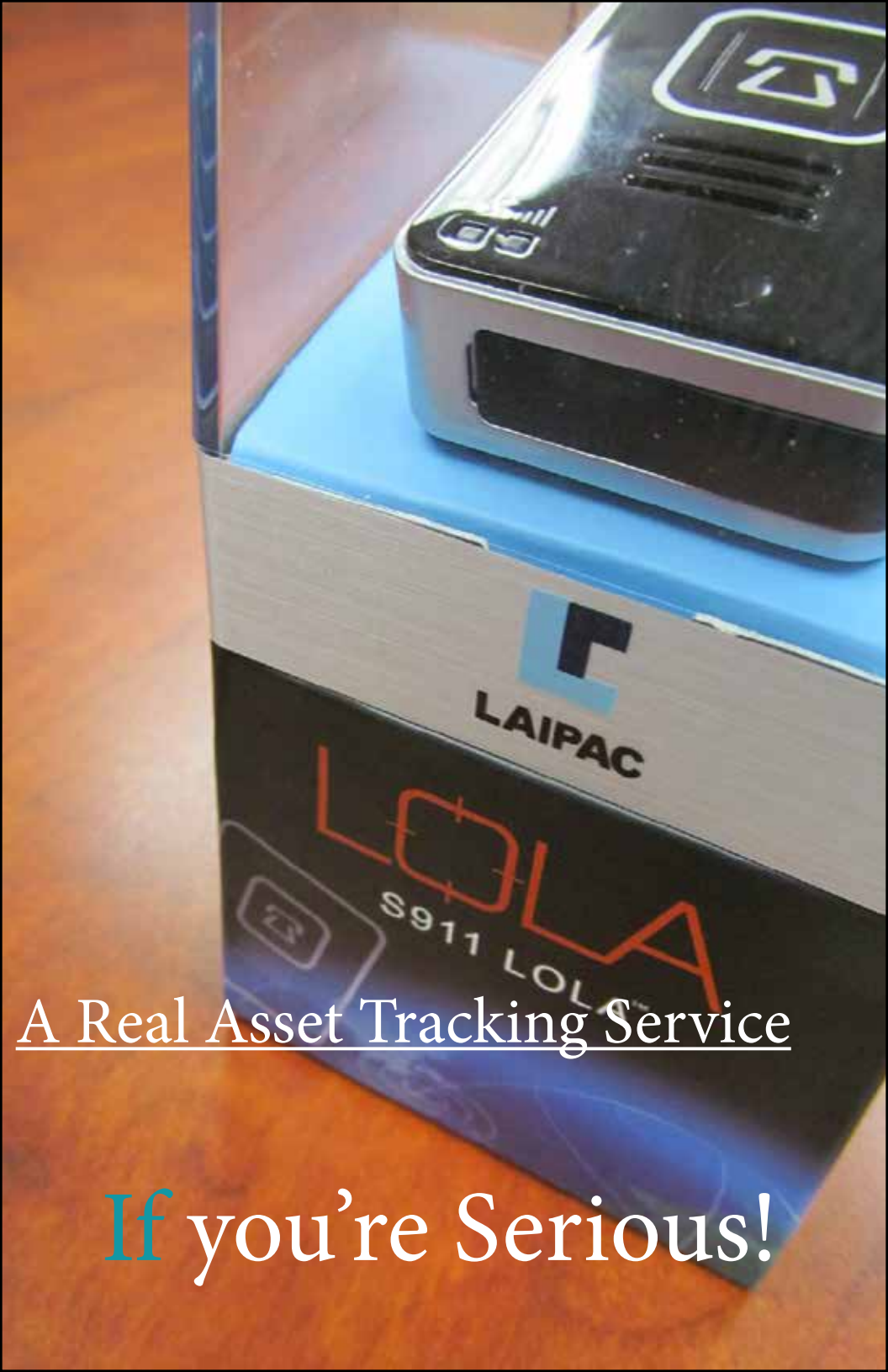
With the support of our 24/7 real-time threat intelligence reporting service (see PIP below), we can stay one step ahead of developing threats and contact the client immediately if he or she is moving in the direction of a potential problem.

BASIC SERVICE

This is our most basic GPS tracking service. Basically we provide the GPS unit (personal and vehicle devices available) but we don't monitor movements unless an emergency unfolds where we are called on to provide tracking and response assistance.

Our monitoring center is open 24/7 with a free 800 number and a Nextel radio, so there will always be a response to any calls from subscribing clients.

ADVANCED SERVICE

24/7 GPS Tracking:

Continuous tracking of personal and/or vehicle devices. Through GPS tracking and other pre-established communications mechanics (phone, radio, email, text, etc.), our monitoring operators can keep continuous track of a client's movements and plans, whether on their daily routine or if they are traveling. If this is coupled with our 24/7 real-time intelligence reporting service, then we can stay one step ahead of developing threats and keep the client out of danger. This combination can be a powerful risk prevention tool if employed properly. Threat Intelligence Support: With the support of our 24/7

real-time threat intelligence reporting service (see PIP on next pages), we can stay one step ahead of developing threats and contact the client immediately if he or she is moving in the direction of a potential problem. But this service is only as good as the participation of the client. If we receive prior information on travel plans, routes, destinations, etc. then we can apply our risk analysis tools ahead of time and be able to provide important threat information that can help prevent an incident, such as making recommendations for route changes.



Crisis Management and Support Services

Command and communications support during emergency situations, based on pre-established procedures, to include (but not limited to):

- 24/7 operator available to receive emergency/distress calls (or email/text/Twitter, etc.).
- Provide emergency communications hub and network if necessary.
- Trigger crisis management plan procedures.
- Notify all relevant participants in the crisis management team.
- Maintain communications and coordination supervision, keeping a log of activities, making sure the plan is on track according to the established crisis management plan.
- Live real-time monitoring of developing events by our security experts, providing timely feedback and recommendations if new developments require a deviation from the determined course of action.
- Notification and/or coordination with headquarters, authorities, vendors, clients, press, etc.

Field support during emergency situations, such as (but not limited to):

Kidnapping

Extortion or other threat (bomb, workplace violence, etc.)

Medical emergencies

Vehicle theft, accident or malfunction

Victim to arbitrary street crime

Lost in a city and can't find your way to safety

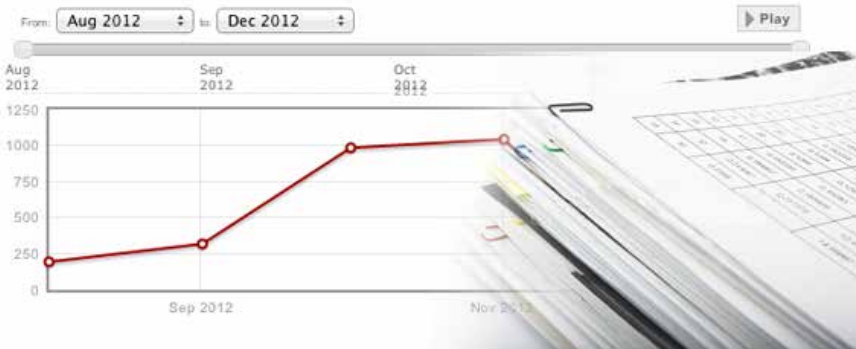
CRIME MAP & INCIDENT REPORTS

This service platform is designed mainly for security managers that need to have timely intelligence on what the threat posture is around their areas of operation in Mexico. The map utility shows where crimes have taken place, which can be very useful if you need to know what crime is developing near your factory or executives' homes, or you need to plan routes for visiting VIPs, or if you need to find out what the threat levels are for an area that you are visiting or are planning to establish a site.

On a more strategic level, there is also a trend analysis tool that can show you if a particular area is getting better or worse. There are many benefits that can be obtained from this platform and whatever your particular needs may be, if you have a site in Mexico or are [travelling there, this becomes an essential component of your risk management tool box.](#)

Strategic Analysis

Our second service platform is more of a blog-type utility where we are continuously posting news events and our own analysis on incidents and issues of strategic importance. Sometimes it will be an expansion on a particular event that occurred that day that we think merits further analysis and comment, or it could be an analysis piece on a number of events or trends that we have noticed through our daily research. Either way, these analysis reports are meant to give more depth to the issues, so it's not just about crime data, but also about understanding the data.



Knowledge Base

Our third service platform is intended for those who are more inclined to dive into the depths of our crime database and do their own research to come up with their own conclusions. We have robust search functions such as dates, locations, crime categories, criminal groups and more. The importance of accessing our database is that not all events have a specific address, and those that do not, will not show up on the map, so they are absent from that system. However through this database you will be able to access all reports, whether they are mapped out or not.

24/7 Real Time Reporting

Based on specific criteria that each client gives us, we have intelligence analysts continuously monitoring a wide range of intelligence sources (from public to confidential), sending out reports of events as they happen directly to the individuals in need, instead of just posting them on the website platform. Depending on each client's criteria, dissemination could be a simple text message sent out to a pre-determined list of recipients, to a more direct phone call when urgency demands that a specific event is communicated to a specific individual immediately.

This can be a very powerful risk prevention utility, and even more so if the client is also involved with our 24/7 tracking service. The strength of these two services combined is that if we are continuously tracking the movements of key personnel, as we receive information on developing risks, we can compare this to their movements and quickly act if a key person is moving towards an area of potential danger. This service can be contracted on a continuous basis or as a temporary service for travelers.

For Travelers

Traveler Dossier, delivered to the client before and/or during (updates) a trip, can include:

Training

We have develop short courses (2-3 hours) that travelers can take through the internet or in person which will give travelers practical skills that will improve their ability to avoid crime.

Threat and risk analysis reports:

This can be done on a regional, city or neighborhood level. Results would include practical information on what the direct threats could be to a client's particular business in a particular area, as well as recommendations of location options based on security considerations.



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
